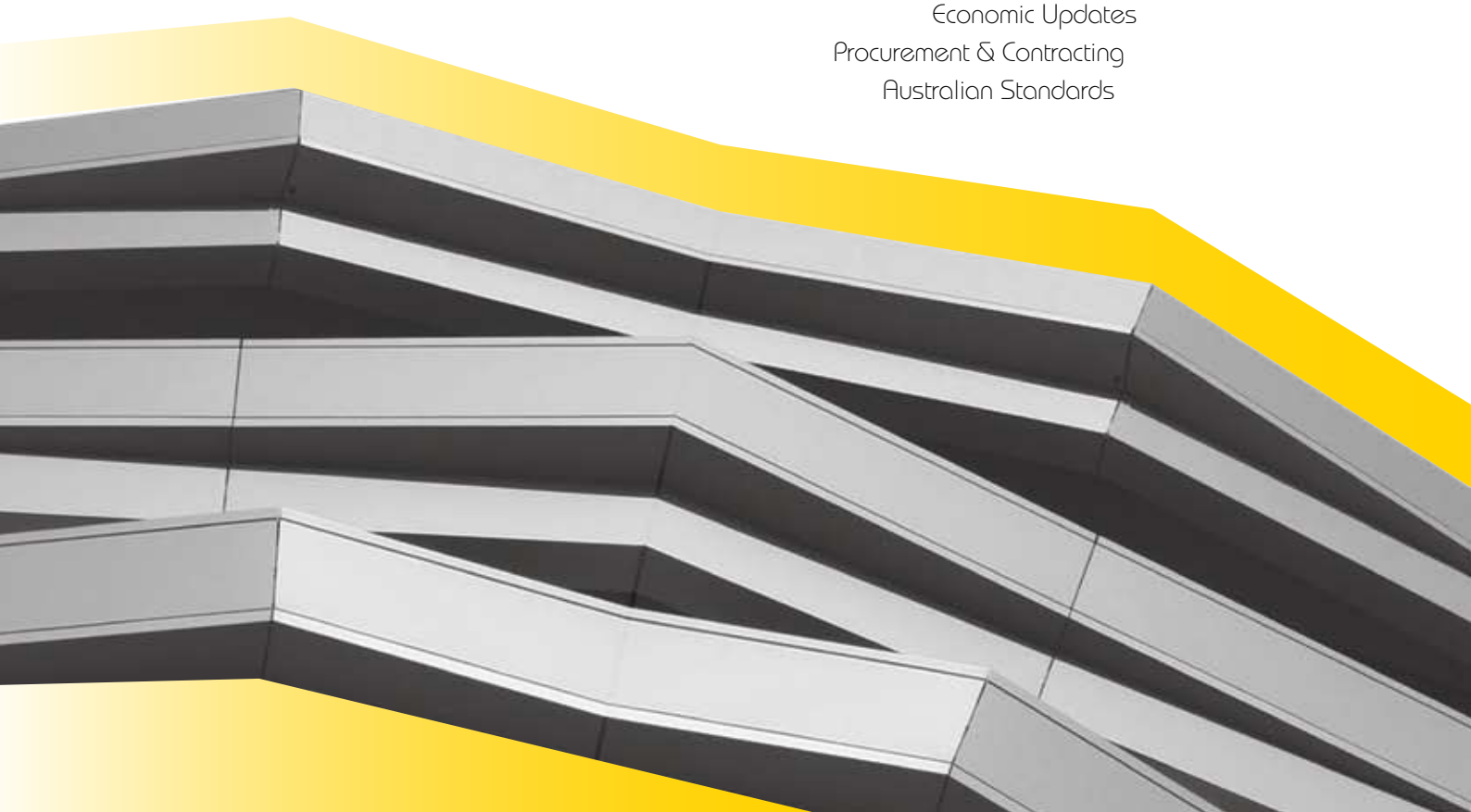
Construct 2010 gives delegates an opportunity to hear from a diverse list of speakers on a range of topics relating to the building and construction industry.
