1. Professional recognition

AIB's grades of membership provide a structure for your peers and prospective employers to identify you as a Chartered Building Professional whose experience and qualifications have been subject to independent assessment. For more than sixty years these have been a recognised means of distinguishing those with a commitment to their own professionalism and well-being of the entire building profession.

Members have the opportunity to influence government policy through the AIB Industry and Government Liaison Committee and provide direction in the AIB's work supporting policy development through the Australian Construction Industry Forum (ACIF). Extensive opportunities exist to participate in policy development at a local level through participation in your local AIB Chapter.
